

Environmental Health and Safety

This core area addresses issues important in minimizing exposure of the campus community to harmful agents, and in enhancing protection of the environment at large. Topics include biological and chemical laboratory safety; hazardous and other special waste management; occupational health and safety; ergonomics; emergency and disaster procedures; and awareness of applicable local, state, and Federal regulations and policies.
